

Town of Woodboro Board of Supervisors
Meeting Minutes December 10, 2013

Pledge of Allegiance was recited

Meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. by Chairperson Sherry Tischendorf

This board meeting was posted on the four (4) normal posting locations within the township.

All board members were present Chairperson Sherry Tischendorf, Supervisors Lois Haese and Phil Kriesel. Treasurer, Tina Schmidt and Clerk, Sue Ann Johnson.

A motion to approve the November meeting minutes as read was made by Supervisor Kriesel and seconded by Supervisor Haese. Motion passed with all ayes.

Treasurer Schmidt gave a report with an adjusted balance of \$441,321.70.

First agenda item was Oneida County settlement of special assessments. It was decided by the board to not do anything with the county about the special assessments.

Next agenda item Oneida County Planning and zoning letter. The planning and zoning is making revisions in article 2 zoning district. The Chairperson handed out copies of the letter so it can be looked at and addressed next month. There will be a meeting at the Cassian town hall on January 9, 2014 at 1 p.m. so Karl Jennrich from Planning and Zoning can explain the revisions.

The election board was approved as follows;

Marilynn Orton, Debra Durschlag, Jacqueline Rudis, Rita Lemmens, Dixie King, Lois Haese and Dorris Meeuwsen.

Next agenda item was Denny Thompson, Oneida Co Board Representative; Denny talked about the county possibly charging the townships for damages done to foreclosed properties within the township. Denny said that there are currently only 2 cities who are involved in the county chargebacks, Three Lakes and Rhinelander. Denny also talked about Woodboro tax foreclosure property that is available. Denny mentioned that he will be retiring at the end of his term in April 2014.

Next agenda item was Oneida Lake Access survey. Supervisor Kriesel said that he has not heard anything from the surveyor, Loftus.

Next agenda item was Northwoods Passage snowmobile club routes. The snowmobile club has mapped out a new route, down Oscar Jenne Road to Oneida Lake Road to Reicherts Drive. The existing ordinance will be amended to add Oscar Jenne .6 miles west. Chairperson Tischendorf made a motion rescind the snowmobile ordinance amendment of August 13, 2013 motion was seconded by Supervisor Kriesel. Motion passed all ayes. Chairperson Tischendorf made a motion to accept the new snowmobile route amendment seconded by Supervisor Kriesel. Motion passed all ayes.

Next agenda item was Woodboro town roads;

There were some complaints about some of the roads not being plowed. Chairperson Tischendorf has been in contact with Highway Maintenance about this.

Motion was made by Supervisor Kriesel seconded by Chairperson Tischendorf to adjourn the meeting at 6:59 p.m.
