

Town of Woodboro Board of Supervisors

Monthly meeting minutes

April 8, 2014

Pledge of allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairperson Sherry Tischendorf.

Meeting was posted in the normal 4 posting places within the township.

Board members present were Chairperson Sherry Tischendorf, Supervisors Lois Haese and Phil Kriesel, Treasurer Tina Schmidt and Clerk Sue Ann Johnson.

A motion was made by Supervisor Kriesel and seconded by Supervisor Haese to approve the March minutes as written. Motion passed all ayes.

The treasurer gave a report with an adjusted balance of \$484,779.69.

First agenda item was Tom Gietman in reference to vacating some of the road right-of-way on Rambling Lane.

Mr. Gietman was present and is asking the town to vacate part of a platted road on Rambling Lane. He would like to build a different structure on his property at 1987 Rambling Lane. He is having issues with setbacks because of this platted road right-of-way. Chairperson Tischendorf did some research and had some maps on hand from 1923. These maps showed a deviation from the actual course of the road as it is constructed today. The town is recommending that the Gietman's contact all parties involved who share a driveway on this right-of-way so all options can be addressed. The town is also recommending that a survey be done to clear up these issues. The town is not the party requesting the change so the town would not be responsible for paying for the survey.

Next agenda item; Fire numbers

A motion was made by Supervisor Kriesel and seconded by Supervisor Haese to pay for the signs-fire numbers- that will be put up at the ski/biking parking lots on Washburn Lake Rd and Hancock-Oneida Rd. Motion passed all ayes.

Next agenda item; Appointing Jacqueline Rudis as a deputy clerk

The appointing of Jacqueline Rudis as deputy clerk was tabled at this time as Jackie would be signing checks and taking responsibility for the checks without knowing what the checks are for. Jackie does not want the responsibility of learning the rest of the clerk's job.

Next agenda item; Town roads-updates

We did get the TRIP grant-the town will have to replace the culverts on Birch Bay Rd when doing the construction on this road. Supervisor Kriesel will check out what exactly has to be done. He will check with Oneida County commissioner Freeman Bennett so the town will be in compliance.

Denny Thompson former Oneida County supervisor stopped by to say thank you to the town for allowing him to represent them during his reign as Supervisor.

A motion was made by Supervisor Kriesel and seconded by Supervisor Haese to adjourn the meeting at 6:44 p.m.
