Monthly meeting minutes

July 8, 2014

Pledge of allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. by Chairperson Sherry Tischendorf.

Members present were Chairperson Sherry Tischendorf, Supervisor Phil Kriesel, Treasurer Tina Schmidt and Clerk Sue Ann Johnson, Supervisor Lois Haese.

Agenda was posted in all four places.

Supervisor Kriesel made a motion seconded by Lois Haese to approve the June meeting minutes as written. Motion passed all ayes.

A treasurer's report was given with an adjusted balance of \$470,050.39.

Chair Tischendorf to meet with lawyer and Geitman will pay for attorney's fees for vacating road right-of-way.

Selling of signs will be at end of the meeting.

Culvert permits have been sent in for Birch Bay Rd. project.

Highway Maintenance, Dean Bettinger, gave a report – all roads are graded. He has been doing some blacktop patching and cleaning up of storm damage.

Chair Tischendorf talked to WI Town Association, Carol Nawrocki, and she was told we could write an ordinance pertaining to parking along County Park Rd.
