

Town of Woodboro Board of Supervisors

Monthly meeting minutes

October 14, 2014

Pledge of allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairperson Sherry Tischendorf.

Members present were Chairperson Sherry Tischendorf, Supervisor Phil Kriesel, Supervisor Lois Haese, Treasurer Tina Schmidt, and Clerk Judy May.

Agenda was posted in all four places.

Supervisor Kriesel made a motion and seconded by Supervisor Haese to approve the September 9, 2014, and September 16, 2014, meeting minutes as written. Motion passed by voice vote.

Treasurer's Report was given by Tina Schmidt with an adjusted balance of \$489,622.62.

New Business:

First agenda item: Greg Nevinski, Lake Rest Rd. Mr. Nevinski spoke on behalf of the residents that live on Lake Rest Rd. and expressed safety concerns due to the lack of signage on Hwy 8 leading to the private road, Lake Rest Rd. New road sign requested.

Old Business:

First agenda item: Tire recycling will be held at Woodboro Town Hall on Saturday, November 1, 2014, from 9 a.m. to noon. Residents may bring up to 25 tires per person to be recycled. Notices to be posted at four posting places.

Second agenda item: Reichert Road – According to Oneida Title and Abstract, the Town of Woodboro does not have an easement to the road in question by landowners George and Joann Beltz.

Third agenda item: ATV Vehicle Route Ordinance #01-14 approved at the town board meeting held on September 9, 2014, was amended to reflect the speed limit changes on Oneida Hancock Lake Road from 25 mph to 35 mph effective with posting 10/14/14.

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Fourth agenda item: Town Roads updates – Culvert project for Birch Bay Rd has been put on hold until Spring 2015. Patching, grading and brushing work has been taking place throughout the town. Tod Loftus continues to work on Oneida Lake access information. Judy May, Clerk, was instructed to write a letter to Mr. Wesley Dietz, Old County Rd K, asking to move the debris from his collapsed building away from the roadway before snowplowing commences.

Public comments: Tina Schmidt requested the board set the Budget Workshop and Hearing dates. The budget workshop is scheduled for Thursday, Nov. 6, 2014, at 5 p.m. The budget hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, Nov. 11, 2014, at 5 p.m. before the regular town board meeting.

Mike Barnes inquired about the status of Birch Bay Rd. Mr. Walldinger has a new attorney and there are no further updates on this matter.

Guy Hansen is requesting directional signs for the ski trail be placed. Action was tabled and will be put on next month's agenda.

A motion was made by Supervisor Haese and seconded by Supervisor Kriesel to adjourn the meeting at 6:40 p.m. Motion carried by voice vote.
