

**Town of Woodboro Board of Supervisors  
Public Hearing Meeting Minutes  
October 17, 2017**

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Chair Kriesel called the public hearing to order at 5:30 p.m. Confirmation of appropriate notices.

Roll Call-Members present: Chairperson Phil Kriesel, Supervisors Bill Rudis and Tom Schmidt, Clerk Judy May, and Treasurer Tina Schmidt. There were 14 audience members present.

**New Business:**

1. Public Hearing on proposed Nuisance Ordinance. Chair Kriesel asked everyone to look through the proposed Nuisance Ordinance. The audience members were given eight minutes to review. Chair Kriesel gave the history of why the town board was considering a nuisance ordinance. Several audience members discussed the problems with dogs barking. Audience member also concerned with lowering of property values due to property owners that leave junk in their yards. The town supervisors agreed that something needs to be done, but the proposed ordinance is too cumbersome. An audience member referenced the town's dog ordinance. The town board is going to review the proposed nuisance ordinance and dog ordinance before proceeding further.
