

Ordinance To Appoint Alternate Election Officials

Wi. Statues Section 7.30 1 (a) and (b) states that a municipal governing body may provide by ordinance for the selection of alternate officials, or the selection of 2 or more sets of officials, to work at different times on election day, and may permit the municipal clerk, or body of election commissioners, to establish different working hours for different officials assigned to the same polling place. Alternate officials shall also be appointed in a number sufficient to maintain adequate staffing of polling places, etc.

I move to adopt an ordinance to provide for the selection of alternate poll workers, and or, the selection of 2 or more sets of poll workers, to work at different times on election day, and also to permit the town clerk to establish different working hours for different poll workers, if so needed.
