

Ordinance Number 0105

TOWN OF WOODBORO PLAN COMMISSION ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Woodboro, Oneida County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Title

This ordinance is entitled the "Town of Woodboro Plan Commission Ordinance".

Section 2. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a Town of Woodboro Plan Commission to further the health, safety, welfare, and intelligent use of resources for the benefit of current and future residents of the Town through the development and implementation of comprehensive planning with significant citizen and Town Board involvement.

Section 3. Authority; Procedure for Adoption

The Town Board of the Town of Woodboro has been authorized by the Annual Town meeting under sec. 60.11(2)(c), Wis. Stats., to exercise village powers. The Town has a population of less than 2,500, according to the most recent regular or special federal census, sec. 990.01(29), Wis. Stats. The Town Board hereby exercises village powers under sec. 60.22(3), Wis. Stats., and establishes a five (5) member Plan Commission that will include at least one citizen member who is not a Town official, under secs. 60.62(4), 61.35, and 62.23, Wis. Stats. The Plan Commission shall be considered the "Town Planning Agency" under secs. 236.02(13) and 236.45, Wis. Stats., which authorize, but do not require, Town adoption of a subdivision or other land division ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date

Following passage by the Town Board, this ordinance shall take effect the day after the date of publication and/or posting as provided by sec. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
