

**TOWNSHIP OF WOODBORO  
DESIGNATED SNOWMOBILE ROUTE ORDINANCE**

The Town Board of the Township of Woodboro does hereby adopt an ordinance designating the following roads as a snowmobile route in accordance with Section 350.04 and Section 23.33 (8) of the Wisconsin State Statues;

Reichert Rd.

Oneida Lake Rd-south .6 miles from Reichert Rd

Woodboro Springs Rd-trail intersection south .85 miles

Birch Bay Rd-southern most intersection south .2 miles to county line

Roe Lake Rd-trail intersection west to end of road

Memorial Forest Rd-north of Hwy 8 .3 miles to trail intersection, .7 miles north

Trout Creek Rd-northern town line south 1.3 miles

This ordinance is in effect only during the winter snowmobile season ending March 31<sup>st</sup> of most current season. The above roads will be open for use as a snowmobile route on the same schedule as the Oneida County snowmobile council trail ordinance.

It is understood that the routes on the above mentioned town roads will be properly signed by the Northwoods Passage Snowmobile club in accordance with state laws and regulations.
